The Baltimore Schooner *Chasseur* ultimately became one of the fastest, most feared and successful ships in the fledgling U.S. Navy during the War of 1812. Captain Thomas Boyle took dozens of prizes all through 1814. When *Chasseur* returned home in early 1815, the celebrated schooner was labeled the "Pride of Baltimore" by her thousands of admirers throughout the colonies.
