In the mid 1920's, N.J. Blanchard Boat Company and Lake Union Drydocks were busy building production cruising yachts for the waters of the Puget Sound area. They called these "Standardized Cruisers" and Lake Union Drydocks called their models "Dreamboats". Our new model is of a 42' Dreamboat which was one of the most popular sizes made by Lake Union Drydocks in Seattle. Our model features all planked construction including top decks, teak & holly look standing deck aft, red bottom paint and varnished cabins. Special care was taken to replicate many of the features of the Dreamboat which still can be found on the waters of Puget Sound.
