The Reliance was the largest single masted boat ever built to compete in the America's Cup. She carried over 16,000 sq. ft. of sail area and a crew of 62 men. Reliance was considered the crowning achievement of designer and builder Nathaniel G. Herreshoff. Skipped by Charlie Barr, the Reliance won all three races against the Shamrock III.
