

CHRISCRAFT DOUBLE COCKPIT

1934

The new Double Cockpit Forward Runabouts were introduced in 1934 and featured the V-windshield and airplane type cockpits. They used a stern-mounted engine with direct drive. James Smith designed the new style introduced by Chris-Craft in 1934. By 1936, these were offered in 3 sizes, 16, 18 and 19-footers. They had a price range from \$945 to \$1550 for the 19' which was equipped with a 93-horsepower engine. Claims were made that it would reach speeds of 36 miles per hour.
